ZIP/CITY Monthly Update

September, 2017

Your September update of the ZIP/CITY System is enclosed.

The enclosed update contains the September, 2017 USPS city/state database information. It is valid until 12/31/2017. Please install this update as soon as possible.

Even though you are receiving monthly updates and there is considerable overlap in the expiration dates, we strongly encourage you to continue to install updates as soon as possible after they are received.

Military Postal Service Agency

An extension of the U.S. Postal Service, the Military Postal Service Agency (MPSA) provides Department of Defense personnel, their family members and other authorized users with mail services around the world.

- The Military Postal Service Agency is the managing authority over Military Postal Service (MPS) operations.
- MPS customers receive virtually the same level of service as if they were at home in the United States. Differences are based on the country in which they are stationed and the type of military operation in which they are involved.
- Until 1980, each military service and government agency managed its own mail program. In 1980, the MPSA was formed and the Department of Defense designated the Secretary of the Army as the single military mail manager.
- Created to link all the partners together with a common goal, the MPS provides postal services to military personnel around the world.
- Military mail moves within the United States via the Postal Service transportation network to major postal mail processing facilities.
- If the mail is via First-Class Mail, Priority Mail or Priority Mail Express, it will move from major airport gateways in the U.S. to overseas airport gateways on commercial U.S.-owned aircraft. From the overseas airport gateways, mail is then moved by various methods to the designated Post Office facilities for delivery to the individual service member.
- The MPSA provides service to 110 countries.
- There are 224 land-based Post Office facilities and 143 on ships.
- There are 952 ZIP Codes for military mail around the world, with more than 1.2 million delivery points.

ZIP Code Activity

No new Zip Codes were added for September. Seven existing Zip Codes were removed for September. A complete list of Zip Codes added and removed can be viewed by selecting option 1 from the ZIP/CITY Menu and pressing the F24 function key.

FIPS Code Updates

No new FIPS Codes were added or removed for September.

Area Code Updates

Three new Telephone Area Codes were added for September:

1. Telephone area code 223 was added as an overlay for south-central Pennsylvania. Telephone area code 223 covers the same geographical area as telephone area code 717.
2. Telephone area code 838 was added as an overlay for north-east New York. Telephone area code 838 covers the same geographical area as telephone area code 518.
3. Telephone area code 986 was added as an overlay for the entire state of Idaho. Telephone area code 986 covers the same geographical area as telephone area code 208.

One new Telephone Area Code was added for August. Telephone area code 564 was added as an overlay for western Washington. Telephone area code 564 covers the same geographical area as telephone area codes 206, 253, 360, and 425.

CD-ROM's

This is a reminder about CD-ROM's. The CD-ROM's we send to you become your property. We do not expect you to return any of them to us.

You should always retain the current and the prior update, but after that, they can be disposed of in any manner you deem proper.

To install an update of the ZIP/CITY System do the following:

1. Sign on as any user with *ALLOBJ special authority.
2. Have all users sign off the ZIP/CITY System library. The ZIP/CITY System must not be in use during the new release installation. QTEMP should be in your library list.
3. Load the ZIP/CITY System CD-ROM.
4. Key LODRUN DEV(device name)
5. You will be asked to select the load method: Interactive or Batch.
6. If you select batch, you will be prompted for the start time. When the update ends, you will receive a message telling you that the installation has completed.
7. If you select interactive, upon completion of the installation, the ZIP/CITY System main menu will be displayed.
8. The new version number is **Z.17.09**
